Julie Wise helped reestablish the literary journal *Amarillo Bay*, which has published since 1999 and currently has subscribers in 27 states and 9 other countries. She is editor-in-chief and webmaster of the newly-designed website: www.amarillobay.org. She also serves as acquisitions editor for Ink Brush Press. An assistant professor of English for the University of South Carolina Aiken, Julie Wise earned her PhD and her MA from Indiana University, where she focused on Victorian studies, and her BA from the University of Michigan. Before arriving at USCA, she had taught at USC Columbia and Allen University.
